How to download the mobile app:

How do I change information in my account (email address, password, name)?

All account information can be modified from your account page after logging in. Simply click the person icon in the top right corner and click **"Account"** from the drop down menu.

I can't log in. What should I do?

Most likely, you are not using the correct email address to sign-in. First, check to see where your confirmation email was sent. If you cannot find a confirmation email, send your first and last name and the email address you believe you signed up with to support@benchprep.com

What internet browser should I use?

We recommend using Google Chrome, Firefox or Safari.

A portion of my course is not loading, what do I do?

This usually happens for 1 of 2 reasons.

- 1. You are using BenchPrep on Internet Explorer. Internet Explorer does not fully support our technology. For best results, we recommend using Google Chrome, Firefox, or Safari.
- 2. Occasionally, the download process is interrupted or does not occur properly.

To ensure you are seeing the best version of your course, follow these steps:

- 1. Login to your account and open your course
- 2. Click the person icon in the top right corner
- 3. Select "Help" from the drop down menu
- 4. Go to the question, "A portion of my course is not loading, what should I do?"
- 5. Click the provided link to refresh your course
